Dear Friends & Supporters,

Each year we eagerly embrace opportunities to best serve our community. This fiscal year (July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023), we implemented a robust strategic plan, developed over a nine-month period by a dedicated group of board members, community volunteers, and NSSC's leadership team. Guided by consultant Becky Frederick of Workplace Solutions, the process involved stakeholder interviews, focus groups, and many passionate discussions, resulting in a comprehensive three-year vision.

Our areas of focus include: Talent (our committed employees, volunteers, and board members), Technology (identifying critical technology needs and resources for effective delivery of programs and services), and Telling the Story (communicating our impact on aging). Incorporated holistically in each of the three focus areas is Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI), ensuring true representation of all those we serve.

We're proud of what we have accomplished this year: communications templates incorporating inclusive language; an audit of our current messaging strategies and technology inventory; and donations of equipment to improve hybrid programming. We developed a matrix for our Board of Directors and have begun recruiting new members. As part of our DEI initiatives, employees participated in Ageism and Workplace DEI training, and completed LGBTQ+ older adult training earning the organization a respected SAGECare credential. There are many more accomplishments highlighted on the following pages.

While proud of our achievements, there's more to be done. As Ruth Bader Ginsburg said, "Real change, enduring change, happens one step at a time."

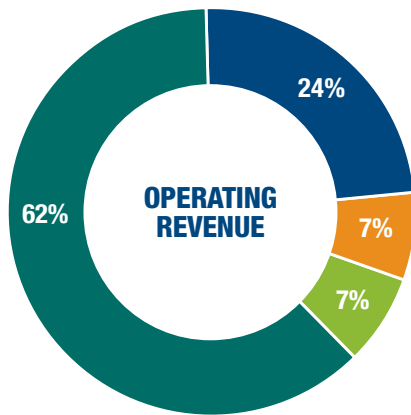

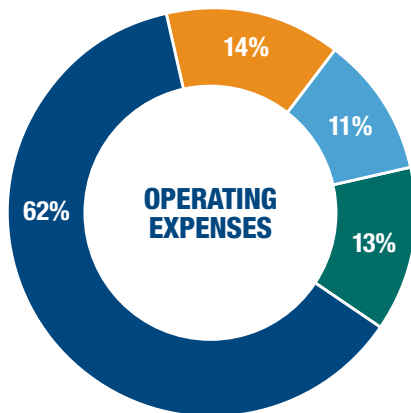
